TASRO is seeking presenters that will provide quality training to school-based police officers, school administrators, and other school safety professionals. Training sessions must offer information on current trends, present new skills, and engage attendees in an information-packed learning experience. TASRO training sessions provide learning opportunities for SROs, SSOs, educators and administrators at all levels of experience.

Training sessions will not be utilized to promote products or services.

Submissions

- I. Complete all areas of the form, including the attachment of the Learning Objectives. Incomplete proposals will not be considered.
- II. Presenters will submit a request for all travel expenses to be reviewed by the board for approval.
- III. Training sessions will be either 2 hours or 4 hours in length unless otherwise requested by TASRO and conducted between the dates July 12 – July 15, 2027, in Corpus Christi, Texas.
- IV. Break out trainers will not receive a stipend and must pay all travel expenses; however TASRO will provide up to two trainer(s), with a paid conference pass.
- V. When reviewing proposals, preference will be given to trainers who have not trained at a TASRO conference in the past two years.
